

8.0 RAIN CHECK POLICY

- At the discretion of the Manager on Duty, a golfer may be issued a rain check if they are unable to complete their round.
- A rain check will not be issued unless the conditions materially deteriorate from the time the round begins to the time a rain check is requested.
- Rain checks are good only on the course where issued.
- Rain checks do not expire.
- Rain checks must be presented at time of redemption.
- Lost rain checks MAY be replaced at the discretion of the Head Golf Professional of the course where the rain check was issued or by the Director or Golf.
- With purchase of a 9-hole or 18-hole green fee, a rain check shall be issued for the # of holes that were not completed. For example, if a golfer only completes 3 holes before inclement weather hits, the golfer will receive a rain check for the remaining 15 holes. This rain check will be in the form of a (\$\$) Dollar amount that can be applied towards the golfer's next green fee purchase.
